Dear Voter,

We are a newly formed party, founded after the approval of the new road toll package by local and district Councils in December 2014. This package, which includes expensive toll rings encircling Stavanger and several other towns, passed without a single assessment in terms of the impact it will have for the local population, institutions, business, sport, voluntary organizations and others.

Stavanger is facing an uncertain future. Whilst people are losing their jobs and businesses are struggling, can we then sit quietly by while those who represent us impose an additional tax of up to 36,000 kroner per car, per year without a proper analysis of the consequences? That is the equivalent of an average 31% wage tax increase!

How will this affect the recruitment of new workers to the region and the viability of existing jobs? How will individuals and families who rely on a car be able to save to get into a tight housing market or purchase essential services? How will it affect our purchasing power and general quality of life? What will we have to cut down on? These are among the questions we ask ourselves. These questions and many others should have already been considered had the existing politicians done their job properly.

The traffic problems in Stavanger are the result of misguided policies. Commercial and residential buildings have been located far apart with little investment in infrastructure despite a huge population growth. We are tired of politicians who simply push problems into the future, instead of solving the problems they themselves have created.

“Folkeaksjonen nei til mer bompenger” insist that such unfair, ill thought out policies as those now proposed should never be forced upon the people of this region. We will do everything we can to reverse the decision about the new toll rings.

Your vote has the opportunity to help shape Stavanger’s future. We have taken responsibility by representing the population from whom we have received very strong support. If you want change however, you must support us by giving us your vote in local elections on the 14th September. Without it, we will not get anywhere.

TRANSPORT

Culture and sports should be available for everyone, both young and old. We will support both new initiatives and established cultural events.

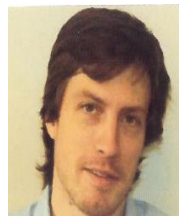
- Ensure youth clubs are available in all districts
